We offer flexible and local language, literacy, numeracy and work skills assessments and learning programs to meet the needs of workers being retrenched and looking to find the right new job.

Many of our services and training programs are fully subsidised. We meet the learning and training needs of workers which often cannot be provided by large education and training institutions.

- Free, no obligation and independent training needs assessments conducted in their local areas
- Wide variety of short courses, and pre-accredited training programs which are fully subsidized. In particular, for retrenched auto-supply chain workers.
- Strong support and training for retrenched workers with language literacy, numeracy, and digital skill development needs

- Career and resume support, and new job search counselling services
