

## How to Sew a Fabric Zipper Case

A zipper case is useful to keep your little things together in the study, sewing room, any place where you are doing any jobs and need small accessories.







## Material needed

You can use an old denim or a curtain that you no longer need

- Cut out 2 pieces of 16 ½ X
   23 ½ cm
- 2. 8" Zipper
- 3. Zipper Foot
- 4. Pattern









#### Tools

Sewing machine

Iron and ironing board





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# Sewing the Fabric Zipper Case

This easy to follow tutorial will show you how to sew a Fabric Zipper Case in just a few minutes.







### **STEP 1:** Organise Fabric

Before you start, you need to organise your fabric and pattern.

- 1. You can make a pattern of 14 ½ X 21 ½ cm.
- 2. Fold the fabric facing wrong sides, pin the paper pattern onto the layered fabric.
- 3. Cut it out with a 1cm seam allowance.







#### STEP 2: Two pieces cut out

- Fold 1cm at the top of both pieces and press
- Hold the zipper using the zipper foot









## **STEP 3:** Sew around

In step 3 we will fold the fabric facing wrong sides, sew with a 1cm seam allowance, as shown in the picture.









#### Sewn around

Sew the Fabric Zipper Case around with 1cm sewing allowance, leave the zip halfway opened so that you can turn it inside out when it's done.





#### Almost ready

Use an overlocker machine or zigzag stitch to make your Fabric Zipper case neater. This will stop the threads fraying off the fabric.







#### Completed Fabric Zipper Case

These are the ones I've made.
