
HOW TO SEW A GROCERY BAG HOLDER

A Cargo Pant that you no longer need, can be used to make this Grocery Bag Holder

This is useful to hang in your pantry cupboard for those extra bags to be held in one place.

This easy to follow tutorial will show you how to sew a Grocery Bag Holder in just a few minutes.











TOOLS

Sewing machine

Iron and ironing board






STEP 1: ORGANISE FABRIC

Before you start, you need to organise your fabric and tools.

- 1. Measure and mark 46cm, draw a line on the pant leg.
- 2. For the handle; you need 26 x 6 cm of the same fabric.
- 3. Elastic 6 x 160mm







STEP 2: TWO PIECES CUT OUT

- 1. One pant leg
- 2. Handle
- 3. 16cm elastic







STEP 3: GET SEWING

- Sew the raw edge with a

 Sew the raw edge with a
 leave a
 passage to pass the elastic.

 After the elastic is passed through secure with a stitch and sew the passage.
- 2. Sew a straight line on the strap and turn inside out.
- 3. Pin the strap on both sides of the top and sew it.







PRESS/IRON

Press your Grocery
Bag Holder for a
neater finish
